### Eligibility Requirements:

- Current resident of Cook County
- Student will be a sophomore, junior, or senior in the coming school year
- Student must attend the summer training

Students that are offered a position on NOPE will meet a minimum of twice a month, once virtually on a school night, and once in person for a longer meeting.

Students will be selected for interviews based upon completion of an application.
